

CONFINED SPACE TRAINING

CITY & GUILDS 6160-03 LEVEL 2 AWARD
IN WORKING IN HIGH RISK CONFINED SPACES



This course is for people who work in high risk environments and includes preparing to work, entering and exiting confined spaces safely, using equipment and tools, following procedures and dealing with emergencies. The aim of this course is to reflect the national occupational standard for a high risk confined space environment. This course covers both water and non-water industries.

Water: where the operative is working in or near water, or where a confined space is subject to surface water flooding. This may include working with potable water, sewage treatment processes, drain and sewer cleaning operations.

Non-water: this may include pharmaceutical, asbestos removal, vehicle manufacture and servicing, aeronautical, construction, communications, power, utilities, gas, electrical and mechanical engineering and some elements of work operations in mines, quarries and tunnelling.

Learning outcomes:

1. Prepare to work safely in high risk confined spaces.
2. Enter and exit high risk confined spaces safely.
3. Use equipment and tools safely.
4. Follow working procedures and work safely.
5. Deal with emergencies.
6. Understand the principles of working in high risk confined spaces.
7. Understand standard protocols for working in high risk confined spaces.
